Wind Farm Excursion, 19 November, 2018

South Australia leads the nation with the number of its 17 wind farms and in 2016, they generated 40% of SA's electricity.

On this trip we will leave Walkerville at 8:30 am (park in Church Street) and view nine wind farms in the Mid North, starting with Waterloo and Stony Gap east of Clare and then those between Burra and Jamestown. Here we will also view the large battery installation as well as the enormous Hornsdale wind farm near Jamestown. Finally, we will head back to Adelaide via Snowtown and the extensive wind farms on the ridge west of the town. We aim to return to Walkerville by 5 pm. The map shows the route.



We hope to have two speakers *en route* to talk to us about the wind farms.

We will stop for coffee at Burra and for lunch at Jamestown.

The cost of the excursion is \$55/person which includes a Subway lunch (Including gluten free wraps) and drinks that we will take with us. If you want to take your own lunch, the cost is \$45. Due to insurance issues, the excursion is open only to RGSSA members and their partners.
